Dear Ms. White,

I was not happy to hear of the owner's request for rezoning. We have way too much traffic as it is on Dreamland. I live down the street toward the railroad tracks (10910 Dreamland), the second house past Westby. I don't know if what happened to me will be of any use to you, but I am willing to release any legal documents or police reports to you.

I was on my way home from the HEB on Lockhill-Selma in October of 2000. I was waiting to pull in my driveway when I was hit from behind by a small truck. There was about \$8000 in damage to my car. I was diagnosed with TMJ the following summer. The other driver was not seriously hurt. Every accident I have seen, the cars were a mess, but no serious injuries. It's going to take someone getting seriously hurt or a death to get the attention of the City of San Antonio.

My husband e-mailed the City of San Antonio about the accident and how we really needed speedbumps on our street. The traffic has gotten really bad. Sometimes people honk at me when I slow down to pull in my driveway....it's ridiculous. This is supposed to be a residential street.

I also remember seeing a mutiple car accident within the last month at Lockhill and Dreamland, but I don't remember the exact date,
